Type 1 Procedure

- Write Bible verse for copywork on board
- Write Greek/Hebrew words and their derivatives on board
- Read next chapter in Bible together (break up evenly according to how many readers there are. Make sure and leave time for hymn singing, going over memory passage, and discussion and looking things up.
- Go over Greek/Latin words. Give a short quiz on the words previously presented.
- Get everyone set with their handicrafts (crochet, knit, embroidery, Sculpey, beading, watercolors, pastels, etc. if there were little ones this would include playdoh and coloring)
- Read aloud from *The Book of Virtues* and discuss.
- Read aloud from our current novel and discuss (there may be a separate one for the littles and the olders).
- Have some do independent study, penmanship, and/or self-read while helping others with arithmetic, McGuffey's lessons, or grammar
- Eat lunchboxes, clean up.
- Go on walk, maybe read aloud from a nature book on something we have seen, make entries into nature journals

Type 2 Procedure

- Write Bible verse for copywork on board
- Write Greek/Hebrew words and their derivatives on board
- Read next chapter in Bible together (break up evenly according to how many readers there are). Make sure and leave time for discussion and looking things up.
- Go over Greek/Latin words. Give a short quiz on the words previously presented.
- Get everyone set with their handicrafts (crochet, knit, embroidery, Sculpey, beading, watercolors, pastels, etc. if there were little ones this would include playdoh and coloring)
- Read aloud from various, maybe watch a video, and discuss
- Make assignments; sometimes copywork, sometimes notebooking page, or something more creative.
- Have some do independent study, penmanship, and/or self-read while helping others with arithmetic
- Eat lunchboxes, clean up.

Type 3 Procedure

- Practice memory verse
- Discuss doctrinal issue, such as Trinity, current trends in the light of Scripture, etc.
- Read aloud from various, watch video, and discuss
- Make assignments; some times copywork, sometimes notebooking page, or something more creative.
- Have some do independent study, and/or self-read while helping others with arithmetic
- Eat lunchboxes, clean up
- Go on an exploratory trip somewhere.
