## Greek

### **Biblical**

#### Focuses on content

• Facts and knowledge are supreme.

#### Focuses on context

• Student learns in the context of a universe created by a loving, personable God.

#### Seeks to shape student's mind

• The student is considered an empty vessel to be filled.

#### Seeks to shape student's <u>heart</u>

• The student is an eternal being with worth imbued by God.

 The student needs only parameters and direction (molding).

# Student patterns after what teacher knows

 Education becomes a cold, mechanized pursuit devoid of heart or passion.

# Student patterns after what teacher <u>is</u>

• Follows the pattern of discipleship exemplified by Jesus with His disciples.

#### Efficiency driven

 Knowledge is organized into subjects and programs--"teaching to test" is one of the methods.

#### Relationship driven

• The foremost consideration is the student in relationship with God and others (including family, church, and community).
